Use: Offices & Break Room for Personnel
during Nuclear Shutdown

Size: 19,584 square feet

Background:

This building was used by contractors working during the shutdown of a Nuclear Power Plant. It has offices, a break room, & bathrooms. The customer only needed the original floor plan to accommodate a one-time use. When the outage is complete, the customer will have the building broken down into smaller buildings. For this reason, it was purposely built with an even number of modules. The electric and mechanical systems were designed to currently function as one, but separate in the future. The reusability of the building is the most cost-effective factor for the customer. It will now also handle all future space needs by that customer in other areas of the plant for the next several years.
