Detention Center -Intake Center

NEED

This building is used to book incoming inmates at the Baltimore City Detention Center. The city needed to add space because their existing space couldn't handle the demand.

The biggest challenge faced for this project was the inaccessibility to the building site. The only viable location was close behind an existing structure on an existing concrete pad

SOLUTION

A crane was used to lift the building on to the concrete pad and 30' long longitudinal beams were welded directly to the perimeter frame. Axles and hitches were all removed. The building was also being set very close to another building so two exterior walls had to be fire rated and a sprinkler system installed to meet local fire codes.

Features include:

- (8) Perimeter offices & kitchen area
- Bathroom with prison grade fixtures for inmates and a separate one for staff
- High rib steel exterior, steel doors & vinyl windows for added durability
- Vinyl gyp and 1/8" tile floors
- LED lights and Low E windows
