Project Profile | Custom Modular Building - Detention Center



Use: Inmate Intake Center **Location:** Baltimore, MD **Size:** 24' x 56'



The city needed to add space to book incoming inmates at the Baltimore City Detention Center because their existing facility couldn't handle the demand. The biggest challenge faced for this project was the inaccessibility to the building site. The only viable location was close behind an existing structure on an existing concrete pad that required a custom foundation system for the building to be anchored to.

Solution:

A crane was used to lift the building on to the pad site where 30' long longitudinal beams were required and welded directly to the perimeter frames. Axles and hitches were all removed. Since the building was installed within close proximity to an adjacent structures, two exterior walls were fire rated and a sprinkler system was needed to meet local fire codes.
