Educational Facility - Classical Christian Conservatory School of Alexandria



USE: Permanent Classrooms

LOCATION: Alexandria, VA

SIZE: 28' x 74'

Need

The school's occupancy was at its maximum and they needed additional classroom space immediately in order to stay in operation. They chose modular construction for the speed of delivery. In addition to more classroom space, the owner also wanted overhead protection for students and staff coming and going from the existing building to the new building.

Solution

The reusability of modular buildings proved itself with this project. Wilmot completely renovated a 28x74 modular building to include four classrooms and ADA restrooms. It was then relocated to the school's site in Alexandria, VA. An aluminum canopy was installed between the existing school and the new modular building – providing student and staff overhead coverage from the weather elements.
