- 5/8" Vinyl Covered Gypsum Interior Wall Finish
- 1/8" Vinyl Composite Tile Flooring and Vinyl
- Cove Base throughout
- Oak Base/O.H. Cabinets with 25"x22" Bar Sink/Gooseneck Faucet
- Smart Panel Exterior Siding with 100% House Wrap & Sheathing
- One (1) Unisex ADA Restroom with supply and waste piping stubbed through floor and one (1) 10 Gallon Water Heater
- 125 Amp Single Phase Electrical Panel
- T-Grid Type LED Lights with writing per code
- 3.5 Ton Wall Mounted HVAC Unit with 15kw Heat Strip
